



Fees Notice

Below is an outline of playing fees for 2009 netball seasons. Please direct any further fee enquiries to our Club Secretary.

Important Information...

Fees must be paid before a player will be accepted into a team.

A deposit of \$75.00 is required on registration day per player and can be paid via cash or cheque.

An invoice will be issued for balance payments due. This will be payable upfront or in two instalments. All Cheques are to be made payable to "Parklands Netball Club Inc."

Player's fees are split into two areas:

- (1) Parklands Playing Fees
- (2) National Netball Registration / Insurance

1. Parklands Netball Club Playing Fees

Parklands Netball Club Incorporated is a not-for-profit organization and as such the following fee schedule is designed to recover cost – not create profits. A family discount structure is applicable when two or more family members are playing in the same season. Additionally, a discount is applicable if a child participates in more than one team per season

Player fees cover competition and team entry fees, game day match, court and umpiring fees, training night court hire, club administration, newsletters, training equipment, team equipment, first aid supplies, awards, trophies and presentation. Estimated fees for 2009 seasons are \$175.00 per player per season per team

Note: \$165.00 per player for subsequent family members when playing in the same season;

\$133.00 per player for a second team when playing in two teams within the same season

2. National Netball Registration

Required to be paid ONCE per calendar year

- Seniors: \$53.00 inc GST -- 18 years and over
- Juniors: \$38.00 inc GST -- 17 and under as at 31-Dec-2008
- Modified: \$28.00 inc GST -- 11 and under as at 31-Dec-2008

Note: The National Netball Registration has replaced VNA Registration. If you are joining mid year you may be exempt from this fee if you have participated in a Netball Victoria affiliated competition, as it is transferable between competitions. Please contact the Club Secretary for more information.
